As far as Clark County goes, it encompasses the entire county. We've been on fires that we've been called on clear into Logandale. So in essence we may respond anywhere within Clark County.

Board Member Rutherford – Ok, I understand now. Board Member Rutherford seconded the the motion. Motion passed to accept the Mutual Aid Agreement for Emergency Services. 3-0-0.
