For 2021 YTD there were a total of 139 Fire Calls and 555 EMS Calls for a total of 694 total incidents.

- b. Discussion and possible action re: VFIS (AIG) Property and Casualty insurance renewal Finance Director Arnett presented the Board members with the VFIS (AIG) Property and Casualty insurance renewal document. She explained that for this FY there would be no increase in the Property and Casualty coverage limits and the premium would only increase by \$117. Board Member Rutherford made a motion to renew the VFIS (AIG) Property and Casualty insurance as presented in the renewal document.
 - Board Member Smith seconded the motion. Motion passed to renew the VFIS (AIG) Property and Casualty insurance as presented in the renewal document. 3-0-2
- c. Discussion and possible action re: VFIS (AIG) Accident and Sickness insurance renewal Finance Director Arnett presented the Board members with the VFIS (AIG) Accident and Sickness insurance renewal document. She explained that for this FY the renewal premium for the Accident and Sickness insurance would remain the same as the last FY. She also indicated that the Fire District would be receiving a rebate on this policy because of our request to align the renewal date with the renewal date of the VFIS (AIG) Property and Casualty insurance renewal date (previously 1/27/21-9/1/21, new 9/1/21-9/1/22).
 - Board Member Rutherford made a motion to renew the VFIS (AIG) Accident and Sickness insurance as presented in the renewal document.
 - Board Member Smith seconded the motion. Motion passed to renew the VFIS (AIG) Property and Casualty insurance as presented in the renewal document.

Discussion and possible action re: Resolution 2021-14 Acceptance of AFG grant from FEMA Finance Director Arnett presented the Board Member with an email from FEMA stating that the Fire District has been awarded an AFG grant if the Fire District would agree to the terms of the grant. FEMA has offered an AFG grant to purchase 14 SCBA's, with the condition that the Beaver

Dam/Littlefield Fire District pay 5% of expenses to qualify for 95% of the grant award. The expense for the SCBAs was already factored into the FY 2021-2022 budget. However, the grant award covering 95% of the cost will result in a significant savings to the Fire District.
