RESOLUTION 2026-09

A resolution of the Beaver Dam/Littlefield Fire District Board of Directors accepting the RFC 25-DLA-A09 grant award.

Whereas, The Beaver Dam/Littlefield Fire District has submitted an application for a Rural Fire Capacity Grant (RFC 25-DLA-A09 Grant) for the purchase of Wildland protective gear: 18 sets of Fireman's Helmets, Flame Resistant Pants, and Fireman's Shirts.

Whereas, the purpose of this protective gear is for the upcoming wildland fire season and response to wildfires both nationally and locally. This will provide BDLFD wildland firefighters with high-quality protective gear that combines certified protection, lightweight comfort, unrestricted mobility, and protection from heat, flames and debris.

Whereas, the Arizona Department of Forestry and Fire Management has awarded Beaver Dam/Littlefield Fire District RFC 25-DLA-A09 Grant for the purchase of Wildland protective gear valued at up to \$5,751.50.

Whereas, RFC 25-DLA-A09 Grant requires local government approval authorizing the application and certifying the availability of 50% matching funds, a sum from other than state or federal sources; and

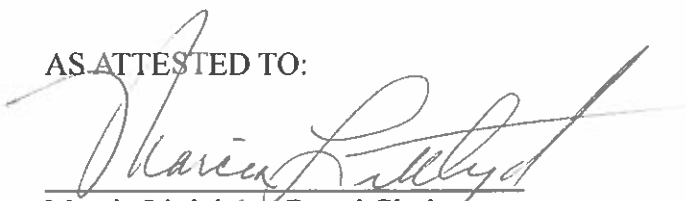
